COST: Retreat fee applies to each Scout and to each adult in an adult course and covers lunch and Retreat materials other than books. Adults staying with a Scout in a youth session pay only \$5 (to cover lunch). Retreat fee: Pre-registration \$15 if payment and completed form (both sides) are received by Carol Beckman by 7 PM Wednesday, 10/02/2019. \$20 for walk-in registrations and those received after 10/02/2019, even if mailed before then. Books are available for those attending the retreat who do not already have them and costs vary (see back). The retreat fee does not include the specific award, which must be awarded with the consent of your church. Cancellations received by Wednesday, 10/02/2019, will receive a full refund. Cancellations after Wednesday, 10/02/2019, will receive a partial refund after the Committee has covered unavoidable costs. If the Scout still wants the book, the refund will be less the cost of the book and any postage to deliver it.

Youth working on the Marian Medal, Spirit Alive, Ad Altare Dei, or Pope Pius XII awards are required to attend a retreat sponsored by the Catholic Committee on Scouting. Religious counselors are required for work on any of these four awards, and must be registered with and approved by the Catholic Committee prior to authorization of any work on these awards.

The Committee hopes any Scout who wants to can attend the Retreat, and so offers scholarships of up to half the Retreat fee (\$10) for Scouts in financial need. Requests for scholarships should be received by Wednesday, 10/02/2019, and include an explanation of the need. Scouts asking for assistance should first ask their unit if the unit can help cover the Retreat cost.
